The Members should be requested to pay their arrears of subscription to enable us to pay to the staff regularly and meet our other requirements. It was decided that a meeting of the Executive Committee be convened after Mr. Masani returned to Delhi to discuss the question of arrears of subscription by the Members and also deficit in order to meet our regular office expenses and what steps should be taken to make up this deficit. Shri C.C. Desai was requested to see through the accounts every month so that subsequently there may not be any objection from any quarters.

It was decided that all Members of our Party should be requested to prepare notes on subjects of their interest or on which they might have enough information to enable the office to circulate the same to Members for their benefit.
