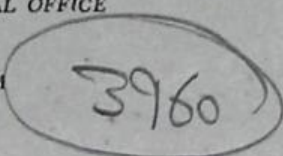

## GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER No. 156

The National Executive of the Party at its meeting in New Delhi on May 21 considered the request of some members who pleaded for a postponement in the last date for enrolment of Workers and Life Workers for purposes of Party elections from June 15 to June 30. The Executive agreed to this request.

As a consequence, the entire time-table for Party elections has now been put forward by 15 days. The new schedule is as follows:
