GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER No. 149

Dear friend,

The National Executive of the Party at its meeting in New Delhi on March 15, 1967, adopted the following time-table for Party elections:

Last date for enrolment of Workers
and Life Workers for purposes of
Party elections .. June 15, 1967

Last date for receipt of Register
Entries and Centre's quota of
subscription .. June 30, 1967

Conclusion of scrutiny of Workers/
Life Workers registers and their
verification .. July 31, 1967

Completion of elections at the
primary (constituency) level .. Aug. 31, 1967

Completion of elections at District
level .. Sept. 15, 1967

Completion of election for State
Committees .. Sept. 30, 1967

Completion of elections for General
Council .. Oct. 15, 1967

Election of National Executive by
General Council .. Nov. 15, 1967

Assumption of office by new National
Executive .. Nov. 15, 1967

2. The Committees at the Constituency, District, State and National levels will assume office immediately on their respective elections. The Central Office, which has now taken on hand the preparation of a detailed Circular in regard to the procedure to be followed in the conduct of these elections, hopes to issue it to State Units in due course.

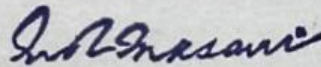
3. In the meanwhile, the following may kindly be noted in regard to the last date for receipt of register entries and the Centre's quota of subscription and the scrutiny of Workers/Life Workers registers and verification. The Register entries and Centre's quota of subscription must be received by the Central Office on or before June 30, 1967. No extension will be possible. Unless this is done, and the registers and books of account kept ready for verification between July 1 and 31, it will not be possible for your unit to participate in the elections to the Party's Committees from the Primary to the State levels. We shall, in due course, inform you the name of the person deputed by the Central Office to look into your books of account and Workers/Life Workers registers.

4. For your information, our representative will look at the following when he visits your State Office for purposes of scrutiny :

- (a) Workers registers, duly completed.
- (b) Life Workers registers, duly completed.
- (c) Enrolment forms of those enrolled.
- (d) Register of Life Members enrolled on or before December 31, 1963, showing all those who have opted from among them to either convert their Rs.10 membership to that of Life Workers or have agreed to convert to 3 and 1/3 year's subscription.
- (e) Breakdown of Workers/Life Workers in terms of the Primary Unit decided upon by your State (Assembly constituencywise, Taluka/Tehsil wise or in the case of cities, Ward-wise).
- (f) A list of primary areas where no enrolment has taken place as on June 15, 1967.
- (g) Books of account indicating allocation of subscriptions as between Primary, District, State Units and the Centre.

5. We trust that the above will be noted carefully to enable our representative to complete the scrutiny satisfactorily.
