GENERAL SECRETARY'S LETTER TO FIELD ORGANISERS No. 6

(For Gujerat Organisers only)

Dear friend,

As a result of discussions between Mr. H.M. Patel and the General Secretary, we are happy to inform you that agreement has been reached on certain modifications in the procedure regarding the Constituency Organisation relating to prospective Parliamentary candidates and Field Organisers.

2. The agreement reached with Mr. H. M. Patel reiterates the decision of the Central Parliamentary Board at its meeting in Bombay on May 26 and communicated to the Party's Field Organisers that, while full time Organisers at constituency levels should continue to send their reports as at present simultaneously to the Central Office and the State Office, they are placed from now on directly under the supervision and control of the prospective candidate and the 3-Man Committee in the Constituency and should do their work in accordance with the instructions and directions of the candidate and the 3-Man Committee, subject to the overall supervision of the State Office and the Central Office.

3. In this connection, may I draw your kind attention to our Circular Letter No. 1-C, namely, that copies of your report and statement of accounts meant for the State Office should be sent to it through the President of your District Unit? In effect this means that the Organiser will from now on work under the supervision of the State Unit through the District Authorities, while his day-to-day functioning will be supervised by the 3-Man Committee and the prospective Parliamentary candidate.

4. In so far as the appointment of Field Organisers is concerned, authority to interview Field Organisers, who have been duly recommended, has been delegated to Mr. H. M. Patel who has kindly agreed to interview such people on behalf of the Central Office and make his recommendation to us. It was further agreed that the remuneration and T.A. of the newly appointed Organisers should be sent to the State Unit. It was also agreed that such Organisers would, however, continue to send reports to the Central Office and to the State Office as prescribed.
