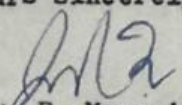
My dear Shenoy,

Many thanks for your letter of 18th and 20th of June and for so promptly helping me with your suggestions. I enclose a copy of the note that we handed over to the Prime Minister in Delhi yesterday. You will see that most of your suggestions find ~~the~~ a place in it, including a paragraph on export duties.
