The Prime Minister, in response to my telegram from Bangalore, has fixed the 22nd instant at 5:00 p.m. for us to see her and I have confirmed the appointment on behalf of Ranga and myself. When Prof. Ranga sees you in Madras on his way to Delhi, will you kindly convey this information to him?

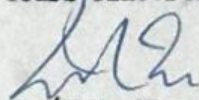
I think it would be useful if we were to hand over a little note to the Prime Minister summarising our constructive proposals in regard to the measures with which devaluation needs to be followed up. This would be useful for the record and will stand us in good stead later in debates in Parliament and our educating the illiterate in due course.

- * I enclose a draft, in duplicate, that I have prepared. It is not of course exhaustive but I do not think anything that is very lengthy would obtain the scrutiny that we would like the Prime Minister and the Finance Minister to make of our proposals. I should be most grateful if you could send me a revised draft of this so as to reach me in Bombay not later than the 21st, as I shall be leaving for Delhi first thing on the morning of the 22nd.

~~left~~ I would like Ranga's approval to the draft also and if he has not seen you by the time this reaches you, would you kindly give him one of the two enclosed copies and ask him to let me have his comments here by the 21st.

I am looking forward to seeing you in Madras on the 2nd July, as planned.
