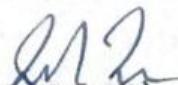
My dear Jain,

Yesterday, on receiving your telegram of the 14th, I sent you a telegram asking you to confirm to the Prime Minister's Secretariat that Prof. Ranga and I would meet the Prime Minister on the 22nd at 5 p.m. as suggested. I have wired Prof. Ranga yesterday on his tour in his Constituency but would suggest that you communicate this information to him as soon as he arrives in Delhi on the 18th.

I propose to come up to Delhi by the morning plane arriving in Delhi on the 22nd at 10:15 a.m. and will contact Prof. Ranga soon after arrival. I propose to return to Bombay the same evening by the plane leaving at 7 p.m.

I note from your telegram that the appointment is still a tentative one but I do hope there will be no further change and that if there is I shall be notified well in advance. In particular, will you kindly see that I am free to leave for the air-port at 6 p.m. that evening as my house is locked up and I have nowhere to stay.
