My dear Shri Masani:

I am in receipt of your letter of 8th June 1966. You must have received my express telegram which I had sent to you after receiving information from the Prime Minister's Secretariat that in reference to your telegram of 6th instant the Prime Minister had agreed to discuss/decision of the Government of India to devalue the rupee on Monday 13th June at 5.--- p.m. in her office in South Block. Now I find from your letter that Monday would not be convenient to you as you would be busy in connection with the Bangalore Convention. I am, however, awaiting for your reply before I inform the Prime Minister's Secretariat that instead of 13th some other day might be fixed for you and Shri Patil.

Neither the Prime Minister's Secretariat nor myself have received any communication from Prof Ranga as to whether he would be coming to meet the Prime Minister or not. When you meet him in Bangalore you would know his programme.
