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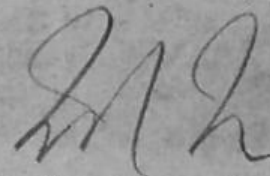

My dear Ranga,

I have received a hint from Sir Homi Mody that his son, Piloo, might be permitted to attend the meetings of the Central Organising Committee and General Council in Bombay although he is a member of neither.

Knowing your views in this matter, I propose to relax the correct procedure to the extent of telling Piloo verbally that he is welcome to be present at the meetings. I am sure you will agree that to issue any official invitation would not be desirable as there are other senior members of the Party in Bombay who would, in that case, have as good a case to be invited. If I do not hear from you to the contrary, I will take it that you approve.
