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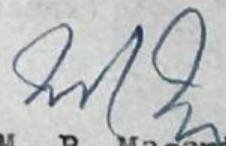

My dear Ranga,

It has been pointed out by friends in the Press that our present arrangement of having a closed Session on Saturday afternoon and two Sessions open to the Press on Sunday is not a good one as it will mean that the opening address and the presidential address and all the resolutions will have to compete for space in the morning papers of Monday the 3rd thus killing one another. We are, therefore, changing the programme by having the two open Sessions on Saturday and Sunday at 2.30 p.m. with the closed Session on Sunday morning at 9, thus ensuring Press coverage for the opening address and some resolutions in the Sunday papers and for the balance of the resolutions in the Monday papers.

Our Reception Committee in Bangalore and the Press have been informed accordingly. This is just for your personal information so that you may be ready to deliver your address on Saturday the 1st at 2.30 p.m.
