My dear Sreenivasan,

I understand you are thinking of changing over the venue of the Convention from the Hall to a Pandal, as you expect a big attendance of delegates and visitors.

I advise you to stick to the original plan, viz., Hall for the Convention and a big meeting at the end of the session in an open Maidan.

It is better to have an over-crowded session in a Hall with an overflow crowd outside listening to the mike than to have a big Pandal only one third full and a big vacant space left unfilled.
