My dear Masani,

✓ I have your letter of January 15. I write at once to say that I fully agree with what you have arranged, viz., that the first sitting of our Convention on Saturday afternoon should be not open to the press and visitors and that you should give a press interview on the conclusions.

✓ Your idea that my opening remarks and Ranga's address should ~~also~~ be delivered the first thing on Sunday morning is quite good and the sessions on Sunday morning and Sunday afternoon should be open to the press and visitors.

✓ I do not think we should discuss our organisational amendment and the state of our membership and finances before the press and the public.

✓ I shall go through your draft resolutions which you have sent me and which reached my hands only this evening. I shall try a draft resolution about friendship with Pakistan as you have suggested.
