My dear Rajaji,

I thought I would share a few thoughts with you in regard to various matters which may come up for discussion in Bombay during your forthcoming visit.

1. Your extra-curricular engagements.

As far as we are aware you have the following three engagements:

- (a) public meeting under the auspices of the Bombay Swatantra Party at the Cawasji Jehangir Hall on the evening of Monday, June 29.
- (b) Rotary Club lunch at Green's Hotel on Tuesday, June 30 on 'India and her neighbours', at 1.15 p.m.
- (c) Address to the ICWA on 'The Future of our Sub-Continent' on the evening of Wednesday, July 1 at 6.45 p.m. at the Indian Merchant's Chamber, Churchgate.

I shall greatly appreciate it if you will kindly keep me informed of any other commitments you may make, including lunch and dinner engagements, etc. In fact if you have not made any such engagement, I hope you will continue your usual practice of referring to me so that we may prevent overlapping.

2. Various papers are being circulated to members of the Parliamentary Board, Central Organising Committee and General Council in respect of certain items of the agenda. You will see these as you receive your formal circulars. ~~We are releasing the Kejriwal complaint and explanations in reply to members of the Parliamentary Board only.~~ A background paper of a factual nature in regard to Kashmir and a note reporting on the unfortunate experience in dealings with the Jan Sangh are being circulated to members of the General Council. The latter has become necessary in view of the aggressive and mendacious propaganda being carried on against us by certain elements in the Jan Sangh trying to give
