As I have already informed you the memorandum to the President has gone off along with all the five signatures including yours. I have already sent you a copy.

I mentioned among the matters to be reviewed at our meetings in Bombay "the change of Government" as there have been a lot of enquiries from people who somehow assume that a change in our attitude is called for. It is precisely to give a quietus to this kite-flying that we should affirm our position on the lines indicated in your letter with which I entirely agree.

I am afraid you have not appreciated the difficulties *about* of Piloo. He is not the chief of the Unit. He is only the Vice-President. Dandekar who is the President has already been invited.
