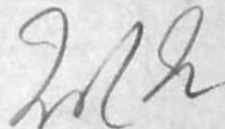
My dear Rajaji,

Thank you for your letter of the 5th.

I thought I would explain the Jaipur mystery to which you refer. The Sadr-i-Riyasat sent for Maharani and persuaded her to telephone V. P. Menon. She later realised that she need not have done anything about it.

I have just received your telegram approving of the dates of the Parliamentary Board Meeting on May 16th and 17th. I am at present planning to reach Madras at 13.45 hours on Saturday the 16th and to return to Bombay on the afternoon of Monday the 18th at 14.30 hours. If, however, you wish me to come a day ahead of the meeting, I shall do so but in that case perhaps you would not mind my returning to Bombay on the afternoon of Sunday the 17th.
