My dear Masani,

I have your letter of April 21.

I think your speech on 17th April was perfectly rounded, and it was well you accepted the suggestion of your group not to touch Kashmir unless provoked. I am much better. But the irritation in the throat and nose and the mucous membrane reaction continue still.

All the towns in the Aruppukottai constituency Virudhunagar Kamaraj's town, Sattur and Sivakasi, I am told, voted by a majority for our candidate. But the rural area in these two Nadar constituencies were bought up or affected by the anti-Nair appeal of the Rajah of Ramnad.
