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**P.M. pursuing
wrong policy,
says Masani**

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NAVSARI, Feb. 17: Addressing an election meeting at Laxman Hall here on Monday, the chairman of the Swatantra Party, Mr. Minoo Masani, accused the Prime Minister, Mrs. Indira Gandhi, of pursuing a wrong economic policy and pointed out that the public sector was incurring a loss of Rs. 40 crores annually.

He said the licence-permit-quota system had encouraged corruption, malpractices and hoarding and added that he would do away with the Planning Commission as all the five-year Plans formulated by that august body had failed to deliver the goods.

He described the parliamentary election as a struggle for supremacy between the Marxist and Gandhian values.
