Sub: Inquiry into the anti-Party activities
of Mr. Bhagwanjibhai Patel

As you are aware, I reported to the National Executive when it met in New Delhi on Sunday, April 14, that the Enquiry Committee appointed by the Gujarat State Unit to inquire into charges of anti-Party activities by Mr. Bhagwanjibhai Patel in the last General Elections, had come to the conclusion that Mr. Bhagwanjibhai Patel was guilty of having worked against Mr. M.R. Masani, the then General Secretary of the Party, who was the Party's candidate from the Rajkot Parliamentary Constituency in the General Elections of 1967.

The National Executive decided that in view of the very grave nature of the findings in this case by the Committee of Enquiry, the President of the Gujarat State Unit should be requested to consider the report of the Enquiry Committee in consultation with your State Executive Committee and to submit its recommendations in regard to disciplinary action to be taken by the National Executive. Kindly take further action accordingly and let me have your report soon, (well before the next meeting of the National Executive at the end of May 1968).
