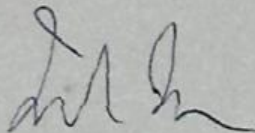

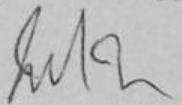
Herewith as promised a draft letter to Dandekar and the draft of a Confidential letter to members of the General Council.
