Dear Brother Masani,

I was shocked to learn that you resigned from the executive of the party. I do understand that it was your noble attitude which compelled you to do that. Nevertheless, friends of the party everywhere felt it.

I could not write to you earlier as I am not keeping fit. I have been very anxious to meet you and Sri Dandeker to discuss Bihar affairs and my own ideas to develop it. I was also anxious to discuss the matter with Sri Sundermani Patel. But we did not get any opportunity to sit alone. He is expected to come here and I propose to discuss details with him. I do not like the matter to discuss in a committee as it might have many bad repercussions. Nevertheless, the party needs an operation if we have to succeed.

I write this so that you may appreciate this, ^{and} relieve me of the responsibilities. I assure you that I am yours and I do stand firm on the ideology.
