Dear Sri Dandekar,

Please find attached herewith a copy of the pattern of voting that I, being the counting agent of Sri B. P. Singh, have finally arrived at. The complete chart is with me and a copy of it can be despatched to you if you want it.

If case I am wrong in my deductions please tell me so

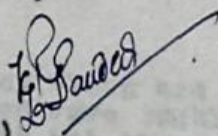
