

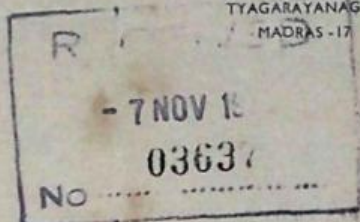

My dear Masani,

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Your letter of November 2. You may take it I shall be in Delhi on November 24 for an evening gathering of the Moral Rearmament at the persistent request of my grandson Rajmohan Gandhi.

I am yet not sure of the exact day before that when I shall reach Delhi as I have not received definite intimation from the St Stephen's College people to whom I have agreed to give an evening on 22nd or 23rd November for an Andrews lecture.

Let your Organization Sub-Committee be fixed therefore for a convenient hour in the morning on Sunday 24 November 24.

I have your previous letter also. My suggestion is that our National Convention should be a business-like Hall meeting with very little pomp or show. I believe that delegates should bear all their expenses. It does not matter if the gathering is not large but is representative. However others among us may hold different views. I agree with you about the time of the convention. I fear Bombay is the only place where we can hold it.

I have noted with pleasure that you have got into international news over Taiwan and Mr. Nehru is defending your freedom in Free India!
