My dear Masani,

Here is a letter I received from Munshi yesterday:

" Raja of Ramgarh met me. He was all persuasiveness, trying to make out a case for keeping things going in Bihar. He says that if we do not want him and his friends, he is prepared to go out and re-form the Janata Party. He says that 46 minus 8 - 38 members in the Assembly and the Council, who form the Opposition, are with him; the others are joining the Congress. He should, therefore, before the Assembly meets, be in a position to form such a party; otherwise they will lose their position as an organized party in the Assembly and the Council. I have asked him to write to you.
