Please refer to your letter of August 24. My letter of August 20 to Ramgarh was on my own initiative. I had received no communication from him or any other to which it was a reply.

I have read H.K.Srivastava's letter copy sent by you. Thin paper gets stuck to the gummed edge of the envelopes and it is not possible to open them without losing torn parts of the thin matter.
