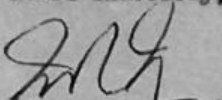
Rajaji has passed on to me your letter of 7th June to which I had already replied in an earlier letter.

Rajaji makes the point that to make the defence of the country the only issue for a united front is not wise. He suggests concentrating on good government.

Since I wrote to you last, Mainstream of June 8 has written something which vindicates my view: "In this respect, the Right has a lesson to impart to the Left today. It did not go in for summit negotiations among its different components but preferred unity in action, and that has paid it rich dividends."
