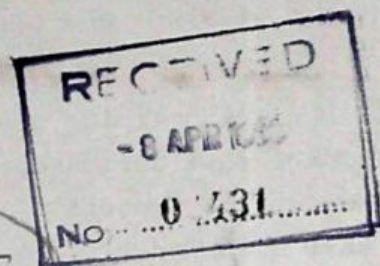

My dear Masani,

Thank you for your letters. I am sorry for my inability to be in Delhi when you come here next.

I have however, asked Sardar Kapoor Singh, Secretary and Jain to issue notices to all our Members to meet you and Shri Dandekar on the 11th at 5-15 P.M., at the Western Court Lounge for a Tea and talk. My secretary Ramamurthy will fix up re: the use of the Lounge. So, kindly wire both Ramamurthy and Jain about your detailed programme.

I am glad to say that so far we have been able to set up our speakers for every demand which has come up for discussion. I have myself had to speak on the Irrigation & Power (2) Home, (3) Community development and today on Defence. I am glad to say that on the whole our party's contribution has come to be appreciated by the Press.

My demand for ending the artificial emergency has drawn a lot of adverse comment from a number of papers notably the very first issue of the "Patriot". But my demand for the abolition of the Community development Ministry found general support from large sections of the Congress.

I do not know what the Press would say tomorrow about my today's speech on Defence. Except Communists all other sections appreciated it in the House.

Mr. Dahyabhaiji and myself ^{are} leaving tomorrow for Patna. I would be in Calcutta for few hours on the 9th and in Nidubrolu on the 11th and 12th and will be touring in Badvel constituency between 14th and 17th instant. ^{Rajajee will be there on the 14th inst.} I have to return to Delhi by the 19th to be in time for the Finance Bill. Mr. P.K. Deo is expected to return to Delhi in a day or two.
