Draft Minutes Of The Meeting Of The
ORGANISATION SUB-COMMITTEE held on January 30, 1964
in Rajaji's Room, Madras Woodlands Hotel, Bangalore

The minutes of the Organisation Sub-Committee meeting held on August 3, 1963, in Madras were confirmed.

Arising from the minutes, the General Secretary reported that, at the instance of the U.P. State Executive, the Organisation Sub-Committee had agreed to Mr. B. P. Singh acting as President and Mr. Layaq Singh as General Secretary for the time being. The Organisation Sub-Committee decided that the present arrangement in regard to the State Office-bearers should continue.

After considering the representations dated December 17, 1963 and January 19, 1964 received from Dr. Krishnamurthy and Mr. Satyanarayan Mishra respectively in Orissa, it was decided that the Organisation Sub-Committee saw no reason to interfere with the decisions of the State Executive Committee. Those persons who had sent representations to the Centre should be informed accordingly.

The General Secretary reported on the inability of the Gujarat Unit to see through the programme of elections upto the State level which had been sanctioned by the Central Organising Committee at the instance of the Gujarat Unit.

In so far as Organisation of the Party in Madhya Pradesh was concerned, the Organisation Sub-Committee decided that the Central Office should encourage and guide such districts as are capable of organising the Party. The developments of these district units should be watched, so that at a proper time they may be brought together for the purpose of forming a State wide organisation.

The Central Office should take similar steps in regard to West Bengal also.

At the instance of the U.P. Unit, it was decided to recommend to the General Council that Sardar Ram Singh and Mr. Chaitanya Raj Singh should be coopted to the General Council.

Similarly it was decided to recommend to the General Council that the following six persons should be coopted to the General Council at the instance of the Rajasthan State Unit:

1. Thakur Raghubeer Singh of Bissau, M.L.A.
2. Shri Radha Krishan Goel, M.L.A.
3. Dr. Chaora
4. Shri Devi Singh of Mandava
5. Shri Ayuman Singh
6. Shri Chiman Singh of Chanot.

It was decided to recommend to the Central Organising Committee that Mr. B. P. Singh, the new President of the U. P. Unit, should be coopted to the Central Organising Committee in place of Mr. S. K. D. Paliwal, who had resigned from the Central Organising Committee.

Mr. S. K. D. Paliwal's resignation from the Vice-Presidency of the Party was recorded.

Since Mr. Kamakhya Narain Singh of Ramgarh expressed his desire to resign from the position of the Vice-President of the Party as also his membership of the Organisation Sub-Committee, the Organisation Sub-Committee recommended that these resignations should be accepted.

The Organisation Sub-Committee resolved to recommend to the Central Organising Committee that Prof. M. Ruthnaswamy and Shrimati Gayatri Devi of Jaipur should be appointed Vice-Presidents in the two vacancies that had been created.

Shri Kamakhya Narain Singh of Ramgarh reported on the unsatisfactory functioning of the State Unit in Bihar. In the light of his report and the discussion that followed, the Organisation Sub-Committee decided to request Shri Kamakhya Narain Singh to convene forthwith a meeting of the present members of the Swatantra Party in both houses of the Bihar State Legislature to carry out the following instructions of the Party:

- i) to elect the Chairman for the meeting;
- ii) to recommend to the Organisation Sub-Committee the names of the President and State Office Bearers for the Bihar State Unit;
- iii) to recommend to the Organisation Sub-Committee the names of members of the Working Committee for the State of Bihar;
- iv) to make any other recommendation necessary for the effective carrying out of work of the Party in Bihar State.

Prof. Ranga was requested to be present at such a meeting.

The meeting then terminated.
