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DRAFT MINUTES OF AN EMERGENT MEETING
OF THE ORGANISATION SUB-COMMITTEE HELD
ON SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 1963, AT 10 P.M.

The minutes of the last meeting were confirmed.

The position in regard to the functioning of the organisation in Bihar in the coming months was considered in the light of the resolution of July 22 of the joint meeting of the Organisation Sub-Committee and Parliamentary Board in Madras, the decisions taken by the Central Organising Committee on February 9 and the General Council on February 10, and the letters of 4th January from the State President to the State General Secretary, of 9th January from the State President to the President of the Party and of 9th January from Mr. Jagat Kishore Prasad Narayan Singh to the President of the Party

As six out of the seven members of the State Committee appointed by the Madras resolution of July 22 were present in Bombay, namely, Shri Kamakhya Narain Singh of Ramgarh, Mr. Ram Binod Singh, Mr. Jaleshwar Prasad, Mr. N. Baksi, Mr. Jagat Kishore Prasad Narayan Singh and Dr. Basant Narain Singh, advantage was taken of this opportunity to invite them to discuss matters informally with members of the Organisation Sub-Committee.

Five of those present, namely, Shri Kamakhya Narain Singh of Ramgarh, Mr. Ram Binod Singh, Mr. Jaleshwar Prasad, Mr. Jagat Kishore Prasad Narayan Singh and Dr. Basant Narain Singh, conveyed to the Organisation Sub-Committee their wish that a new State Committee should be constituted in succession to the present interim committee in order to secure wider representation and to make the more effective functioning of the organisation possible. They informed the Sub-Committee that, at the first meeting of the State Committee appointed by the Madras resolution, which would be convened by Mr. N. Baksi, the General Secretary, they would recommend the following 16 names to form the State Committee in succession to the present interim Committee:

The Organisation Sub-Committee took note of this wish, and intimated that any other names unanimously recommended by the State Executive Committee may also be forwarded by the State General Secretary to the Central Office. At this stage, the invitees withdrew.

The Organisation Sub-Committee decided that, on receipt of these 16 names, the General Secretary should be authorised to give the approval of the Sub-Committee to the new State Committee which was to succeed the present one being so constituted without the necessity of circularising the proposal for the approval of the Organisation Sub-Committee. The General Secretary was similarly authorised to approve of any other additional names that might be forwarded by the State General as being unanimously recommended by the present State Committee provided they did not exceed the maximum of 7 office-bearers and 25 members.
