A meeting of the Party was held this afternoon in the Party Committee Room, Central Hall, Parliament House, when the following members were present:

2. It was observed that members of our Party were seen sitting in seats other than those allotted to them. They were therefore advised to occupy only the seats allotted to them, and not to allow their seats to be occupied by members of other parties.

3. Mr. Masani acquainted the members with the decision of the National Executive of the Party in regard to Bihar members. Accordingly, any member of the Bihar Group intending to come back either as an associate or full member could do so only with the permission of the National Executive after expressing regret in writing. The Parliamentary Group could only forward any such communications if received.

4. There was a consensus that if any attempt was made to bring in a Bill to ~~lower~~ the Quorum the Party would have to oppose it.

5. The following members were chosen to speak on items indicated against each of their names on behalf of the Party:

In regard to the Third Reading of Finance Bill it was decided that a letter should be written by the Leader to the Speaker requesting him to allocate 20 hours for the discussion.

6. It was decided that we should divide the House on the Finance Bill both at the consideration stage and again on the third reading. For that a whip should be issued to all members to be present in Delhi at that time.

7. Members were requested to clear their arrears of contributions immediately. Those in arrears will not be nominated to any Parliamentary Committee. Mr. P.N. Solanki and Mr. Y.N. Singh promised to pay off arrears immediately.

Mr. Dandekar was requested to complete the auditing of Party accounts and get the Report circulated to all members.
