A meeting of the Executive Committee of the Party was held on Wednesday, 16-9-1964, in Committee Room, Central Hall, Parliament House. The following were present:-

Prof. Ranga took the Chair.

It was decided that Shri C.L.N. Reddy should speak on behalf of the Party on the Supplementary Demands for Grants and emphasise on the conditions of the Indians abroad.

Mr. Masani explained the implications of the Companies' Amendment Bill. He said there were serious implications to Government's proposed protection to employees of the Companies, who might act as informers of the Government. Such a protection to the employees was likely to be used for black-mailing the employers. It was decided that while supporting our amendments, these dangers should be detailed by our speakers.

Shri Dhanna Singh Gulshan was nominated to speak on the Private Members' Resolution on rise in prices.

It was suggested that the following amendment to Mr. Biren Dutta's Resolution on Emergency and Defence of India Rules, be tabled on behalf of the Party:-

Add at the end "or for intimidation of any section of the Community for suspected or alleged social or economic activities."

It was suggested that Shri Buta Singh should speak on this Resolution.

It was felt that charges levelled by Mr. Yashpal Singh in his resignation letter against Mr. Masani were baseless and that they should be refuted in a reply which would be sent to him along with a copy of the Minutes of the last Executive Committee Meeting when Mr. Yashpal Singh was offered a seat on the third bench by Shri C.L.N. Reddy and the offer was declined by Mr. Yashpal Singh.

The meeting adjourned with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
