2. Release of Sheikh Abdullah and its impact on the Kashmir question and Indo-Pakistan relations vis-a-vis our Party's attitude and Shri P.K. Deo's speech were discussed. The Members agreed that Prof. Ranga need not participate in the discussion on Demands for Grants in respect of the Ministry of External Affairs.

3. In regard to the Government proposal to send Members of Parliament to various countries to explain India's stand vis-a-vis Pakistan and Kashmir, an opinion was expressed that we should be extremely guarded and might not consider it automatically to be our duty to join such delegations. Therefore, if and when any such invitation comes to be extended, it is for the Leader to advise the Members in case the Executive could not be called.
