It was decided that a Meeting with all the democratic Opposition Leaders be held on Monday, the 16th March, 1964 to discuss the question of setting up of a Non-Political Board for Quota, Permits and Licences on the basis of our Bangalore Convention.

It was suggested that our Members should tour their constituencies and mobilise opinion in favour of our protest march on 30th March against the 17th Amendment Bill. They should ensure that maximum Kisans from their respective places take part in this Protest march.

Report of Sub Committee on Cut motions on various Ministries was discussed and approved. The Executive Committee would, however, feel free to make changes in the light of the situation as it develops.

It was decided that Prof. Ranga should write personal letters to such of our Members, as are in arrears of Rs.200/- or over towards the Party funds. They should be requested to clear their arrears within 15 days; otherwise their names will not be sent by the Party Whip as Speakers and they will not be nominated to any Committees.

The Meeting adjourned with a Vote of thanks to the Chair.
