Prof. Ranga apprised the Committee of a move of Mr. Madhu Limaye regarding initiating the debates on the various demands for grants by rotation by the speakers of the various groups in Lok Sabha. The Secretaries were requested to meet the Minister for Parliamentary Affairs and also the Speaker in this regard.
