Dear Mr. Masani,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 19th instant. Thanks. I note that you will be in Calcutta between the 4th and 7th December. I shall write to you again as to how best we could utilise your presence during that interval.

There has had to be a change in the date of the Conference which has been proposed. Since there was some delay in getting your reply despite my telegram to you, the Calcutta University Institute Hall has been taken up by the Institute itself for its use on the 27th December. When, after I received your letter of the 19th inst. under reference, I approached the Institute Authorities, I found it was too late. In the circumstances, I have engaged the Hall for the next Sunday, viz., 3rd January, 1960, and I have paid an advance of Rs.50/- to be sure of the Hall, and I shall have to pay the balance of Rs.250/- within a fortnight. So, the Subjects Committee will have to meet on the 2nd January, 1960 to finalise the resolutions to be moved at the open conference the next day, viz. 3rd January. These dates also are holidays and are free of any public distractions. Hence, these two dates are suitable. I hence request you to note the change in the date of the Conference, and to keep those dates free. I have also written to Mr. Ranga today (C/o Swatantra Party office at Madras) intimating the change in the dates.

I wonder where Mr. K.M. Munshi is. If he is in Delhi, please intimate to him the change in the dates owing to the circumstances aforesaid. I shall also write to him.
