Dear friend,

Kindly refer to Shri M.R. Masani's letter dated 22nd Oct. 1959 in reply of mine dated 16th Oct. in which I had requested him earnestly to arrange to contact Dr. Jogindra N. Kaul, the ex-Socialist Leader of India now residing in Simla. I had stated that if he once agrees to enter into the Party at least ten thousand people besides several hundred workers of many trade unions would follow.

In his reply dated above Mr. Masani had suggested that I should join Patiala convention and persuade Dr. Kaul also to attend and then decide things with you. But unfortunately his letter did not reach my hands in time therefore, nothing could be done at that stage.

Therefore, now I am to request you very kindly to move into the matter and see if some thing can be done. I am sure if proper approach is made to him he may agree to come into your fold and that will naturally help us to build the party in Punjab, Himachal and Jammu and Kashmir.
