

My dear respected Mesani Sahab,

You will recall my having met you at Bombay at the time of the Convention and subsequently at New Delhi. I had then requested you to kindly give some time for this district.

On 12.8.59 we had formed a provisional Committee to organise the Party in the district. People here are much interested in the principles for which the Party has been formed and we are already busy enlisting support for the Party amongst the public. We propose to hold a district Convention when we shall formally declare our adherence to the twenty-one principles and to launch our membership drive. Such a Convention shall give a good impression upon the public and they shall get an opportunity to enlighten themselves about the ideals the Party stands for. We wish the Convention should be inaugurated by you. Let me hope ^{that} any date in the last week of September or the first week of October shall suit you. 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Your programme in order to cope with our demand to have you here for at least a day. We can decide upon any date that may be suitable to you during the next twenty-five days.

The final date shall be fixed only after hearing from you as to the date convenient to you.

I trust you will not disappoint us.
