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General Secretary's Letter No. 274

Dear Friend,

The Office has already sent you the Manifesto and the Resolutions adopted at the last meeting of the General Council held in Baroda on November 6.

I am writing this in connection with the Resolution on the Orissa Cyclone. You must have read in the papers of the unprecedented havoc caused by the cyclone accompanied by tidal waves, to human lives, crops and cattle. As called for in the last para of the Resolution, we should immediately activate our Party workers from the primary level upwards to help in collecting relief in the following manner :

- (a) Each member of the Party can give cash contributions to authorised representatives of our Party so designated by a responsible office-bearer of the Unit concerned.
- (b) Party Units should approach members and sympathisers and also others who own or manage industries producing consumer goods like blankets, utensils, cloth (dhotis, sarees) and readymade garments to donate their products.
- (c) The State Unit should observe an "Orissa Cyclone Day" on a day convenient to them. On that day, processions may be taken out (after taking care to see that the public in the area where the procession is to go are given adequate notice) to collect money and old clothes.

Cash contributions should be collected in sealed boxes and by authorised representatives only. All such collections in cash or kind should be sent directly to Mr. Ghashiram Majhi, General Secretary, Swatantra Party Orissa, Kharavelanagar, Bhubaneswar. He will acknowledge your contributions and ensure that they reach the people in the cyclone-affected areas.
