Please note that the practice hitherto of giving the name of the candidate with his Symbol on voters slips has been discontinued. Furthermore, such slips must necessarily be printed on White Paper only. No coloured paper should therefore be used.

The Election Commission has also provided a specimen of the unofficial identity slip issued by candidates in a recent by-election in Tamil Nadu.

Kindly ensure that all our candidates in your State are informed of the revised manner of issuing unofficial identity slips.

Sir,

I am directed to refer Commission's letter No. 64/70(1), dated the 18th February, 1970 and letter No. 64/70(1), dated the 29th July 1970 on the above subject wherein the Commission made an appeal to all political parties and contesting candidates that the unofficial identity slips issued by them to the voters should be on plain white paper and they should not contain either the name of the candidate and/or the name of his party and/or the facsimile of the symbol allotted to him.

I am to enclose samples of the unofficial identity slips translated into English, issued by the political parties for the bye-election in Perundurai Assembly Constituency in the State of Tamil Nadu. The slips do not contain either the name of the candidate and/or the name of his party and/or a facsimile of the symbol allotted to him.

The Commission desires that the above instructions may be followed while printing unofficial identity slips at all elections.
