- (a) Endorsed Mr. J.B. Kripalani's remarks at Ahmedabad last week re: Need for good, efficient and honest government which does not exist in the country today.
 - (b) This will need change of present Government through very hard work.
 - (c) Took a pessimistic view of present Government but not of the future of the country.
 - (d) Honest belief that country has lost confidence in the Congress.
 - (e) Opportunity for Swatantra Party to fill the vacuum by explaining to the people the need for an efficient and honest Government. But for this, we ourselves should understand the principles of good, efficient and honest Government.
 - (f) A great opportunity for the Swatantra Party to convince people :
