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Masani indicted

AHMEDABAD May 27.

Members of the executive of the Gujarat Swatantra Party today strongly condemned the statement of Mr. Minoo Masani, former general secretary of the party.

The meeting of the executive was held under the chairmanship of Mr. H. M. Patel, chairman of the State party.

Some of the members expressed their strong feelings that the statement of Mr. Masani had done much harm to the State party and a strong protest should be lodged with the national executive.

The executive unanimously passed a resolution empowering Mr. Patel to convey the feelings of the executive at the national executive meeting, to be held in Madras on May 31.

The executive also discussed the report of the inquiry committee against Mr. Bhagwanbhai Patel, the popular peasant-leader of Gandhinagar.

The inquiry committee held that the complaint against Mr. Patel made by Mr. Masani and others was baseless and Mr. Patel had not done anything wrong against the party in the last General Elections.
