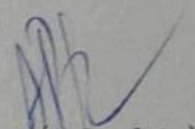

Professor N.G. Ranga, Leader of the Swatantra Party Parliamentary Group, has informed Mr. Ramachandra Amin, M.P. that ^{be convened} his request that a meeting of the Parliamentary Group ^{to} consider the National Executive's decision to remove Mr. C.C. Desai from the Party cannot be placed before the Parliamentary Group since the National Executive's decision cannot be annulled by the Parliamentary Group.

Dealing with Mr. Amin's other proposal that the Parliamentary Group should be invited to censure the President of the Party, Professor Ranga has pointed out that a motion of no confidence in the office-bearers of the Party can only be entertained either by the National Executive or the General Council of the Party, as the case may be, and the Parliamentary Group cannot be expected to consider such matters. Professor Ranga has also pointed out that whatever has been done by the President of the Party has been done through the National Executive and the Parliamentary Group cannot, therefore, consider this matter.
