Two Corrections

To the Editor, The Times of India

Sir.—In an otherwise fair report in *The Times of India* (June 30) July 1) of my press conference in Delhi on June 29, two small corrections are called for.

The first is in regard to the remark that I "compared her (Mrs. Gandhi's) regime to those of Dr. Nkrumah and Dr. Sukarno." What I actually said was that there was a danger of such a development if certain incipient tendencies were not checked in time.

The other point is in regard to Mr. C. C. Desai's expulsion. In answer to a question, I said that normally expulsion of a member from a party is final but that, in view of a request having been made by the Gujarat state council of the party for reconsideration of the decision, the matter had been placed on the agenda of the national executive which was to meet on July 20 in Madras and that the request would then be considered.
