My dear Raju,

I trust you have received my express delivery letter of yesterday along with the enclosed drafts. I have received this morning your reply by telex to my telex message.

Piloo Mody now suggests that the three-column tabulated statement re. C.C.Desai should also be sent to members of the Gujarat State Council. Will you kindly, therefore, obtain their names and addresses from Ahmedabad and add them to the list. There is a possibility that the Gujarat Assembly members might be in Ahmedabad next week in case an Assembly Session is to be called for legal reasons. In that event, the letters to the MLAs will have to be posted to them at their Ahmedabad addresses and not their home addresses. You had better, therefore, also keep their addresses at Ahmedabad ready so that by the time 8th comes round you may be in a position to decide to which addresses these covers should go.

Please make sure that we are in a position to push everything out of the office on the 8th afternoon as anything later will defeat the purpose.

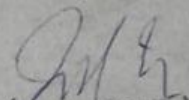
In so far as the invitation to the members of the State Central Parliamentary Board is concerned, H.M.Patel is arriving in Delhi this afternoon and I hope to have a word with him this evening or at the latest tomorrow morning. Unless he draws attention to any difficulty, we shall go ahead with the plan of issuing these invitations.

I understand that Baria will be in Bombay from the 6th onwards and Piloo also hopes to be there on the 6th or 7th. Piloo will be talking to Baria at that time and will report to me at 12 noon on Wednesday the 8th soon after my arrival in Bombay from Calcutta at 9.30 a.m. that day. /by IC130

Incidentally in the draft resolution on disciplinary action you are preparing, I think a definite charge of anti-Party activities should be made in so far as the Presidential election and the later defiance about the stand re. Gujarat are concerned. There should be at some point a charge that he has been working for the ruling Party and in their interests for the past few months if not the whole of last year.
