Dear Minoo:

At a meeting of the Opposition Party leaders' Coordinating Committee in Delhi recently I had raised the possibility of Bangladesh being repeated in India. All members present felt the same. We naturally discussed what steps should and could be taken to stave off such a calamity. As the meeting had been called to consider the people's charter of demands to be presented to the Prime Minister on the 6th March, there was not enough time for a full discussion of the topic I had raised. It was, therefore, agreed that a few top party leaders should meet on the 15th of February, and if necessary on the 16th, in order to consider this question as fully as possible. I am, therefore, taking the liberty to invite you to the proposed meeting, which will be held at 10 a.m. at No. 2, Purana Quila Road, New Delhi.

The only subject on the agenda would be what I have mentioned above. I hope you would be good enough, before coming to the meeting, to have given deep thought to this urgent and vital matter and also to have taken counsel with your colleagues in your Party and with such other friends as you may consider necessary. Considering the importance of this question, I hope you will give this meeting top priority even if you have to cancel your other engagements.
