Dear Minoo,

I write this to keep you informed about further developments regarding Everyman's.

After your discussion with me on our way back to Bombay from Poona, I had considered the offer from various angles.

However, it was only this morning that Mr. Ram Nath Goenka called me to have a detailed discussion with me. In fact, I have just returned after spending more than a couple of hours with him.

You will be pleasantly surprised to know that Prof. A. B. Shah's name was suggested in the same connection to Mr. Goenka by Mr. Achut Patwardhan. Prof. Shah had discussed this with me and I reciprocated by informing him about my discussion with you.

Today Mr. Goenka had a discussion with both Prof. Shah and myself and it seems that he would like both of us to take up this assignment. We have left everything to J.P. and have told Mr. Goenka that we would do whatever J.P. suggests. The rest of the details - the terms, the conditions and the emoluments - may be discussed later.

Therefore, the final decision will be taken by Mr. Goenka after his meeting with J.P. himself.

If not earlier, I will be meeting you on the train to Deolali on the 21st.
