Dear Sirs,

Separately you will have received a copy of the pre-publication dummy of EVERYMAN'S. A booklet containing the policy statement and some other information regarding the Lok Niti Parishad, a registered society responsible for the publication of the newsweekly, will follow.

For a journal such as EVERYMAN'S hopes and will endeavour to be, it is necessary that it should get the support of Indian intellectuals and public-men who have not aligned themselves with existing political parties and who cherish social and democratic values vital for the India of the future. I am, therefore, writing to invite you to contribute to it from time to time in consultation with Shri S.H. Vatsyayan, the Executive Editor at Delhi. Questions regarding subjects or themes you might choose to write on, the length of the articles, periodicity or dates may be addressed to him directly. Normally, however, the ideal article would be 1500-3500 words in length and be due in at the Editorial Office on Thursdays in order to appear in the issue dated the following Saturday (9 days later).

You will have noticed that EVERYMAN'S has a Books & Authors column also. In order that this might be truly useful, it would be necessary to review books from various disciplines and in several languages. It would be very helpful if you could, from your reading, recommend books for coverage from time to time, or indeed send reviews yourself. To avoid duplication, prior reference to the Editor would be desirable.

Once in a while EVERYMAN'S may also entertain a more ambitious essay in depth or a series of two or three essays by different writers on a subject of national importance. Such a series would naturally have to be planned in advance. Should you wish to discuss subjects for such an essay or a series, please feel free to write to the Editor who will welcome all help and suggestions.
