Taking part in the discussion on organisational matters in the General Council the Gujarat Party's leader Mr. Vadibhai Mehta said that the Gujarat Party's organisation has become weak because of Communalism. The two leading communities of Gujarat are having a grip on the State Party's organisation with the result that the people from minorities are being ignored and therefore the Party could not establish a broad base in the State.
