My dear Minoo,

Thanks for your two letters of the 26th and Note to Dr. Cooper of the 25th.

1. I shall attach the revised Note on C. C. Desai as Annexure to the Minutes which, though stencilled, have yet to be duplicated.
 2. Enclosed, please find the cost in regard to the publishing of Swatantra In Parliament. Actually, it is part of a detailed note that I have prepared for Piloo Mody and you will find the entire note attached in this letter.
 3. As mentioned above, the Draft Minutes have yet to be duplicated. Since you have asked that I should send the Minutes to Rajaji by Express Delivery, I am sending him a corrected but typed copy of both the Minutes.
 4. Almost all action in respect of the Minutes have been taken though there are a few items which still need attention and which I hope to complete before you are back in Bombay on the 4th.
 5. About the Jan Sangh, I am sorry I did not understand you properly. I am enclosing herewith the following :
 - (i) Mr. V. K. Sinha's article on the Jan Sangh in the Humanist Review of October-January 1969.
 - (ii) Some extracts on Jan Sangh's views on the Communists.
- I am afraid the English translation of Balraj Madhok's pamphlet is not yet ready but I shall pursue it on Monday and try and hand it over to you when you come to Bombay on the 4th.
6. Regarding your Note to Dr. Cooper (in reply to Mr. V. T. Sreenivasan's letter of 21st February) I had already drafted a letter from Dr. Cooper to Mr. Swalansh, leader of our Party in the State Assembly with copies to Mr. N. K. Ganapaisah and Mr. V. T. Sreenivasan, more or less on the lines of your own answer. I hope to dispatch the letter before we close the office today.
- In regard to the silly condition about members of the Parliamentary Board, giving up the right to stand for election, we have already clarified the matter with Mr. V. T. Sreenivasan, which is also in line with the answer contained in your Note.
7. By oversight, none of us noticed that the decision in regard to by-election in Kerala was left out of the CPB Minutes. Enclosed is a draft and I shall be most grateful if you could kindly have a quick look at it and send it back to me by return of post.

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You might be aware that the Shiva Sena has called for a Bombay Bandh on Monday, the 2nd. If normal life is completely disrupted then, we shall be compelled to keep the office closed.
