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Sir,

Allow me to congratulate you on your election as President of Swatantra Party. Just as Forum of Free Enterprise achieved a wider audience through the formation of Swatantra Party, outright merger with Syndicate Congress will give you opportunity to reach a larger section of the Indian population. The merger should be effected in the event of midterm elections and should otherwise be planned to take place at the end of budget session.

It is essential to topple Mrs Gandhi early in budget session, since she is likely to blackmail princes, as she has tried blackmail on every other political group. It looks as though her definition of socialism is government of India for Birlas by Nehrus. Special monopoly preferences for Birlas should not be condoned and every effort should be made to have Birlas blacklisted and the fertiliser licence revoked. Such an effort would have the widest spectrum of support and I hope Jan Sangh will fall in line.

Dissatisfaction and frustration is likely to deepen unless and until we are able to provide unemployment and old age pensions. Threat of revolution will increase as days go by and therefore, it is essential that Swatantra Party commit itself to Rs.30 pension per month for the unemployed and the old. The only way to finance it would be to join OECD in return for OECD meeting the bill (\$5 billion for India and \$15 billion for South Asia, Africa & Latin America) I think you should take this matter up with SSP, PSP and DMK, and should propose a bill towards unemployment and old age pension scheme at Rs 30p.m. forcing Mrs Gandhi on the defensive.

Since effective result of such a massive social security scheme will be Indian membership of OECD for funds Swatantra Party should join hands with socialists to press for legislation in this area, exposing Mrs Gandhi's offer of banks instead of unemployment pensions, which compares with Marie Antoinette's suggestion to use cakes instead of bread in times of famine. Unemployment and old age pension is an issue which will create the widest coalition now and eventually in favor of OECD.

Sir,

I am glad that you are beginning to realise how extensively Nehru family uses blackmail to secure a consensus and how their lines of blackmail extends across party lines. I hope you are beginning to understand the steady support Nehru's communism gets from the feudal Brahmin clique in Hindi area. Destruction of this Brahmin clique is essential if India is to avoid communism. The secret of Pandit Nehru's Trojan Horse tactics was to introduce communism as a weapon to re-establish Brahmin domination in India. His claim to Andre Malraux that Brahmins will dominate India for centuries and millenia and his claim in Discovery of India that Indian villages had communist system in spite of contrary evidence in the laws of Manu, all point to a well laid strategy to use introduction of collective farming to prop up Brahmin domination and thus establish a reciprocal power feed-back.

You should rouse the Kshatriyas (Maharajas, Rajputs and Jats as well as all farming classes in North India against Nagpur resolution which was passed illegally (with six major state delegations barred from attendance) by Nehru machinations) on the advice of Suslov thesis published in Moscow. Contact Charan Singh and force him to demand repudiation of Nagpur resolution by Mrs Gandhi and Tripathi as a preliminary condition for co-operation in bringing down Gupta Government. Warn Charan Singh of Nehru family machination to use Collective Farming as a ruse to establish permanent Brahmin domination all over India.

I must congratulate you on successfully weaning SSP into an opposition coalition. I think you should George Fernandes, Rabi Ray and Madhu Limaye into declaring themselves against Collective Farming as the critical element in communism and as such should be resisted in co-operation with all democratic parties. You should get George Fernandes and others to demand repudiation of Nagpur resolution and Collective Farming by the Ruling Congress as the first step towards any responsive co-operation as socialists. You should use SSP to force PSP also to assume a rigid posture against collective farming.

The next step in the game is in foreign policy. If SSP could support a move for Indian military assistance to the non-aligned nation Laos from Vietnam aggression and calling of a conference of non-aligned nations of Asia interested in preserving the independence and nonalignment of Laos. An Asian Conference on the lines of the New Delhi Conference on Indonesia should be sought. You should get SSP bring it up as resolution on foreign policy. To balance the resolution and make it attractive to Marxist communist party, you should also seek to express regret at Russian nuclear blackmail against China over the border incidents and express regret at supine pro-Russian policies of India government.

If you could get SSP to formulate such a dual approach, denunciation of Russia for nuclear blackmail of China and simultaneously taking military and diplomatic initiative in preserving integrity, independence and non-alignment of Laos, you will have Mrs Gandhi cornered in foreign policy.

I have an ingenious plan which may not be acceptable to you and perhaps you should not endorse it personally. Suggest to George Fernandes that certain friends who do not mind nationalisation of Banks are worried over the concentration of economic power in the hands of New Delhi and that a compromise proposal to have an Air-India type nationalisation by which private entrepreneurs will have a minority share-holding and majority share-holding in public sector will be equally divided between Central Government and States where the Bank has headquarters. Thus the 14 banks will have separate identity and states will provide a check to undue economic power to the centre. Point out that you are personally committed to maintain a different position but you approve the suggestion tactically to drive a wedge between Mrs Gandhi's communist supporters and DMK as well as Maharashtra supporters. If George Fernandes is willing to buy it, make the best use of it. yours faithfully, A. J. George
