I am enclosing herewith a copy of my letter to Mr.Masani for your kind information. I am glad to inform you that the Bhaskaran Society, a Trust to commemorate Professor R.Bhaskaran has been formed at last and that Mr. Masani has most kindly consented to be on the Board of Trustees.

Since it was found not physically possible, to get the document of the Trust deed, circulated among the mofussil trustees, and we had to get the Trust registered on the 19th itself, which was found auspicious, it was decided to request the local trustees M/S.Dr.C.A.Perumal, Professor and Head of the Dept. of Politics and Public Admn. and T.S.Rama Rao, Professor of International Law, both of the University of Madras, to get the Trust registered, as the Authors of the same and to co-opt the others numbering three including Mr.Masani, as soon as their consent was obtained. Accordingly Mr.Masani as also the others M/s. V.Venkat Rao, Professor of Politics of Gauhati University and K.B.X.Thottappa, Professor of Politics, Mysore University have been co-opted and they are being advised about the same. You may kindly explain the situation to Mr.Masani. However I shall try to meet him during my visit to Delhi between the 3rd and 6th December, and apprise him about the progress. I would request you to look after the Bombay end.

I shall write to you in greater detail and send you a copy of the deed etc. as soon as they are got ready. I trust this letter finds self and family in good health and cheer. With regards,
